Travel grant for young artists from Hamburg curated by Fabian Schöneich

Neue Kunst in Hamburg e.V. is pleased to award five travel grants for artists from Hamburg (up to 40 years old) in 2024. The association, which is financed exclusively through the generous support of its members, would like to give young artists the opportunity to work at a location of their choice for five months. Curator Fabian Schöneich will realize an exhibition with the artists in Hamburg, accompanied by a publication.

The aim of the grant is to give artists living in Hamburg the opportunity to change their work location and create new works. The travel grant also enables the artists to expand their networks and reach. The experiences and impressions gained by the fellows are intended to promote international exchange and stimulate discussions in the field of art in the port city. The five-month residency is designed as a process and the ongoing production is accompanied by discussions with the curator. The final exhibition allows the fellows to present the results of their residency to a wider audience. Each artist will also produce an edition intended for purchase by members of the association Neue Kunst in Hamburg.

The fellows will receive 1,300 euros per month for a maximum of five months during their stay, plus reimbursement of their travel expenses.

The 2024/25 edition of the travel grant is curated by Fabian Schöneich, the founding director and curator of CCA Berlin - Center for Contemporary Arts. The art historian Fabian Schöneich, born in Gera in 1985, was curator of Portikus in Frankfurt/Main from 2014 to 2018. He was also assistant curator at Kunsthalle Basel (2012-14) and Kunstinstituut Melly (2011), formerly known as Witte de With Center for Contemporary Art, in Rotterdam. He curated the performance projects of the LISTE Art Fair in Basel 2013 and 2014 and worked as curatorial advisor for the Focus, Frame and Live sections of the Frieze Art Fairs in London and New York from 2015 to 2017.

He is the editor of numerous artist publications and monographs, including Michael Dean (2024), Lawrence Abu Hamdan: Dirty Evidence (2022), Melike Kara: Where We Meet (2021), Raphael Hefti: Salutary Failures (2021). He studied art history, theory and history of photography and East Asian art history at the University of Zurich.
